# REVEIW: IF I HAVE FOUND FAVOUR: [favour; acceptance; grace] Abraham IF I HAVE FOUND GRACE: [grace; favour; acceptance] Moses



## GOD HATH TOOK AWAY THER VEIL TO REVEAL HIMSELF TO US II CORINTHIANS 3:2 - 18

- » 2 † Ye are our epistle written in our hearts, known and read of all men:
- » 3 † Forasmuch as ye are manifestly declared to be the <u>epistle</u> of Christ ministered by us, <u>written not</u> with <u>ink</u>, but with the <u>Spirit</u> of the living God; not in <u>tables</u> of <u>stone</u>, but in <u>fleshy tables</u> of the <u>heart</u>.
- » 4 † And such trust have we through Christ to God-ward:
- » 5 † Not that we are sufficient of ourselves to think any thing as of ourselves; but our sufficiency is of God;
- » 6 † ¶ Who also hath made us able ministers of the new testament; not of the letter, but of the Spirit: for the letter killeth, but the Spirit giveth life.
- » 7 † But if the ministration of death, written and engraven in stones, was **glorious**, so that the children of Israel could not stedfastly behold the face of Moses for the **glory** of his countenance; which **glory** was to be done away:
- » 8 † How shall not the ministration of the Spirit be rather glorious?
- » 9 † For if the ministration of condemnation be **glory**, much more doth the ministration of righteousness exceed in **glory**.
- » 10 † For even that which was made glorious had no glory in this respect, by reason of the glory that excelleth.
- » 11 † For if that which is done away was glorious, much more that which remaineth is glorious.
- » 12 † ¶ Seeing then that we have such hope, we use great plainness of speech:
- » 13 † And not as Moses, which put a vail over his face, that the children of Israel could not stedfastly look to the end of that which is abolished:
- » 14 † But their minds were blinded: for until this day remaineth the same vail untaken away in the reading of the old testament; which vail is done away in Christ.
- » 15 † But even unto this day, when Moses is read, the vail is upon their heart.
- » 16 † Nevertheless when it shall turn to the Lord, the vail shall be taken away.
- » 17 † Now the Lord is that **Spirit**: and where the **Spirit** of the Lord is, there is liberty.
- » 18 † But we all, with open face beholding as in a glass the **glory** of the Lord, are changed into the same image from **glory** to **glory**, even as by the **Spirit** of the Lord.

#### QUEEN ESTHER - TYPE THE BRIDE

- ESTHER 7:1 3
- » 1 † ¶ So THE KING and HAMAN came to banquet with ESTHER the queen.
- » 2 † And THE KING said again unto ESTHER on the second day at the banquet of wine, What is <u>thy petition</u>, queen ESTHER? and it shall be granted thee: and what is <u>thy request</u>? and it shall be performed, even to the half of the kingdom.
- » 3 † Then ESTHER the queen answered and said, If I have FOUND GRACE in thy sight, O KING, and if it please THE KING, let my LIFE be given me at my petition, and my people at my request:

### DAVID, WHO FOUND FAVOUR BEFORE GOD ACTS 7:44 - 46

- » 44 † Our fathers had the tabernacle of witness in the wilderness, as he had appointed, speaking unto MOSES, that he should make it according to the fashion that he had seen.
- » 45 † Which also our fathers that came after brought in with JESUS into the possession of the Gentiles, whom God drave out before the face of our fathers, unto the days of DAVID;
- » 46 † WHO FOUND FAVOUR before GOD, and desired to find a tabernacle for the GOD of JACOB.

#### **ACTS 13:22**

» 22 † And when he had removed him, he raised up unto them **DAVID** to be their king; to whom also he gave testimony, and said, *I have found DAVID the son of Jesse*, a man after mine own heart, which shall fulfil all my will.
