TEXT:

GOD HATH TOOK AWAY THER VEIL TO REVEAL HIMSELF TO US

II CORINTHIANS 3:2 - 18

- » 2 † Ye are our **epistle written** in our **hearts**, known and read of all men:
- » 3 † Forasmuch as ye are manifestly declared to be the **epistle** of Christ ministered by us, **written not with ink, but with the Spirit** of the living God; not in **tables of stone**, but in **fleshy tables** of the **heart**.
- » 4 † And such trust have we through Christ to God-ward:
- » 5 † Not that we are sufficient of ourselves to think any thing as of ourselves; but our sufficiency is of God;
- » 6 † ¶ Who also hath made us able ministers of the new testament; **not of the letter, but of the Spirit: for the letter killeth, but the Spirit giveth life.**
- » 7 † But if the ministration of death, written and engraven in stones, was **glorious**, so that the children of Israel could not stedfastly behold the face of Moses for the **glory** of his countenance; which **glory** was to be done away:
- » 8 † How shall not the ministration of the **Spirit** be rather **glorious**?
- » 9 † For if the ministration of condemnation be **glory**, much more doth the ministration of righteousness exceed in **glory**.
- » 10 † For even that which was made **glorious** had no **glory** in this respect, by reason of the **glory** that excelleth.
- » 11 † For if that which is done away was **glorious**, much more that which remaineth is **glorious**.
- » 12 † ¶ Seeing then that we have such hope, we use great plainness of speech:
- » 13 † And not as Moses, which put a veil over his face, that the children of Israel could not stedfastly look to the end of that which is abolished:
- » 14 † But their minds were blinded: for until this day remaineth the same veil untaken away in the reading of the old testament; which veil is done away in Christ.
- » 15 † **But even unto this day, when Moses is read, the veil is upon their heart.**
- » 16 † **Nevertheless when it shall turn to the Lord, the veil shall be taken away.**
- » 17 † Now the Lord is that **Spirit**: and where the **Spirit** of the Lord is, there is liberty.
- » 18 † **But we all, with open face beholding as in a glass the glory of the Lord, are changed into the same image from glory to glory, even as by the Spirit of the Lord.**

QUEEN ESTHER - TYPE THE BRIDE

ESTHER 7:1 - 3

- » 1 † ¶ So **THE KING** and **HAMAN** came to banquet with **ESTHER the queen**.
- » 2 † And **THE KING** said again unto **ESTHER** on the second day at the banquet of wine, What is **thy petition, queen ESTHER?** and it shall be granted thee: and what is **thy request?** and it shall be performed, even to the half of the kingdom.
- » 3 † Then **ESTHER the queen** answered and said, **If I have FOUND GRACE in thy sight, O KING,** and if it please **THE KING,** let my **LIFE** be given me **at my petition,** and my people **at my request:**

DAVID, WHO FOUND FAVOUR BEFORE GOD**ACTS 7:44 - 46**

- » 44 † Our fathers had the tabernacle of witness in the wilderness, as he had appointed, speaking unto **MOSES**, that he should make it according to the fashion that he had seen.
- » 45 † Which also our fathers that came after brought in with **JESUS** into the possession of the Gentiles, whom God drove out before the face of our fathers, unto the days of **DAVID**;
- » 46 † **WHO FOUND FAVOUR** before **GOD**, and desired to find a tabernacle for the **GOD** of **JACOB**.

ACTS 13:22

- » 22 † And when he had removed him, he raised up unto them **DAVID** to be their king; to whom also he gave testimony, and said, *I have found **DAVID the son of Jesse**, a man after mine own heart, which shall fulfil all my will.*

- 6 † In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths.
