THE BOOKS

REVELATION 20:11 - 15

- » 11 † ¶ And I saw a great white throne, and him that sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away; and there was found no place for them.
- » 12 † And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and THE BOOKS were opened: and ANOTHER BOOK was opened, which is THE BOOK OF LIFE: and the dead WERE JUDGED out of those things which were written in THE BOOKS, ACCORDING TO THEIR WORKS.
- » 13 † And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell delivered up the dead which were in them: and they were judged every man according to their works.
- » 14 † And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death.
- » 15 † And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire.

A TALE THAT IS TOLD

PSALM 90:8 B-9

- » 8 † Thou hast set our iniquities before thee, our secret sins in the light of thy countenance.
- » 9 † For all our days are passed away in thy wrath: we spend our years AS A TALE THAT IS TOLD.

ALL MUST APPEAR BEFORE THE JUDGEMENT

II CORINTHIANS 5:10 - 11

- » 10 † For we must all appear before the <u>JUDGMENT SEAT</u> of Christ; that every one may receive <u>THE THINGS</u> <u>DONE IN HIS BODY</u>, <u>ACCORDING TO THAT HE HATH DONE</u>, <u>WHETHER IT BE GOOD OR BAD</u>.
- » 11 † Knowing therefore the terror of the Lord, we persuade men; but we are made manifest unto God; and I trust also are made manifest in your consciences.

AN HOUSE NOT MADE WITH HANDS

II CORINTHIANS 5:1 - 9

- » 1 † ¶ For we know that if our earthly <u>HOUSE</u> of this <u>TABERNACLE</u> were dissolved, we have a <u>BUILDING</u> of God, an <u>HOUSE</u> not made with hands, eternal in the heavens.
- » 2 † For in this we groan, earnestly desiring to be clothed upon with our HOUSE which is from heaven:
- » 3 † If so be that being clothed we shall not be found naked.
- » 4 † For we that are in this <u>TABERNACLE</u> do groan, being burdened: not for that we would be unclothed, but clothed upon, that <u>MORTALITY</u> might be swallowed up of life.
- » 5 † Now he that hath wrought us for the selfsame thing is God, who also hath given unto us the earnest of the Spirit.
- » 6 † Therefore we are always confident, knowing that, whilst we are at home in the body, we are absent from the Lord:
- » 7 † (For we walk by faith, not by sight:)
- » 8 † We are confident, I say, and willing rather to be absent from the body, and to be present with the Lord.
- » 9 † Wherefore we labour, that, whether present or absent, we may be accepted of him.

BODY CHANGE

I CORINTHIANS 15:51 - 55

- » 51 † ¶ Behold, I shew you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all <u>BE CHANGED</u>,
- » 52 † In <u>a moment</u>, in <u>the twinkling of an eye</u>, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and <u>THE DEAD</u> shall be raised <u>INCORRUPTIBLE</u>, and we shall <u>BE CHANGED</u>.
- » 53 † For this CORRUPTIBLE must put on INCORRUPTION, and this MORTAL must put on IMMORTALITY.
- » 54 † So when this <u>CORRUPTIBLE</u> shall have put on <u>INCORRUPTION</u>, and this <u>MORTAL</u> shall have put on <u>IMMORTALITY</u>, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written, Death is swallowed up in victory.
- » 55 † O death, where is thy sting? O grave, where is thy victory?

NEW HEAVEN & NEW EARTH

REVELATION 21:1-4

- » 1 † ¶ And I saw a new heaven and a new earth: for the first heaven and the first earth were passed away; and there was no more sea.
- » 2 † And I John saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband.
- » 3 † And I heard a great voice out of heaven saying, Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men, and he will dwell with them, and they shall be his people, and God himself shall be with them, and be their God.
- » 4 † And God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: for the former things are passed away.

REJOICE THAT YOUR NAMES ARE WRITTEN IN HEAVEN

LUKE 10:17 - 20

- » 17 † ¶ And the seventy returned again with joy, saying, Lord, even the devils are subject unto us through thy name.
- » 18 † And he said unto them, I beheld Satan as lightning fall from heaven.
- » 19 † Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- » 20 † Notwithstanding in this **REJOICE NOT**, that the spirits are subject unto you; but rather **REJOICE**, **because vour names are written in heaven**.

PASSED FROM DEATH UNTO LIFE

JOHN 5:24

» 24 † Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that heareth my word, and believeth on him that sent me, hath EVERLASTING LIFE, and shall not come into CONDEMNATION; but is passed from DEATH unto LIFE.
